

THE PRIVACY POLICY OF THIS SITE

WHY THIS NOTICE

This page describes how to manage the site with reference to the processing of users personal data who consult it.

This is an information that is also provided pursuant to art. 13 of Legislative Decree no. 196/2003 - Code regarding the protection of personal data to those who interact with the web services of the company Casoni Srl for the protection of personal data, accessible electronically from the address: <http://www.casoni-cnd.com> corresponding to the home page of the site Company official.

The information is provided only for the Casoni Srl company website and not for any other websites that may be consulted by the user via link.

THE 'OWNER" OF THE TREATMENT

Following consultation of this site, data relating to identified or identifiable persons may be processed. The "owner" of their treatment is of the company Casoni Srl, which has its registered office in Via Marco Biagi, 20 23871 Lomagna (LC).

PLACE OF DATA PROCESSING

The treatments connected to the web services of this site take place at the aforementioned headquarters of the company Casoni Srl and are handled only by technical staff of the office in charge of processing, or by any occasional appointees maintenance operations.

No data deriving from the web service is communicated or disseminated.

Personal data provided by users who submit requests to send information material (bulletins, CD-ROMs, newsletters, answers to questions, etc.) are used for the sole purpose of performing the service or provision requested.

TYPES OF DATA PROCESSED

Navigation data

The computer systems and software procedures used to operate this website acquire, during their normal operation, some personal data whose transmission is implicit in the use of Internet communication protocols.

This is information that is not collected to be associated with identified data subjects, but which by its very nature could, through processing and association with data held by third parties, allow users to be identified.

This category of data includes the IP addresses or domain names of the computers used by the users who connect to the site, the URI (Uniform Resource Identifier) addresses of the requested resources, the time of the request, the method used in submitting the request to the server, the size of the file obtained in response, the numeric code indicating the status of the response given by the server (successful, error, etc.) and other parameters relating to the operating system and the environment computer technician of the user. These data are used for the sole purpose of obtaining anonymous statistical information on the use of the site and to check its correct functioning. The data could be used to ascertain responsibility in case of hypothetical computer crimes against the site.

Data provided voluntarily by the user

The optional, explicit and voluntary sending of e-mails to the addresses indicated on this site involves the next acquisition of the sender's address, necessary to respond to requests, as well as any other personal data inserted in the message.

Specific summary information will be progressively reported or displayed on the pages of the site prepared for special services on request.

COOKIES

What are cookies

They are small text files that the sites visited by a user send to his computer. The text stores information that the site is able to read when it is consulted again by the user.

Some cookies are necessary for the site to function properly, while others are useful to the visitor because they make it faster and quick page navigation. The advantage of having cookies installed on your computer is in the speed of navigation, no longer needing to provide for example the same information to access a site already visited in precedence.

The guarantor for the protection of personal data, with provision of 8 May 2014 (published in the g.u. n. 126), has divided cookies into two macro-categories.

Technical cookies

Technical cookies are those used for the sole purpose of "transmitting a communication over a network of electronic communication, or to the extent strictly necessary for the provider of an information society service explicitly requested by the subscriber or user to provide this service (see Art. 122, paragraph 1, of the code) ".

They are not used for other purposes and are normally installed directly by the owner or manager of the website. They can be divided into navigation or session cookies, which guarantee normal navigation and use of the site web. Analytics cookies, similar to technical cookies when used directly by the site operator to collect information, in aggregate form, on the number of users and how they visit the site.

Functionality cookies allow the user to browse according to a series of selected criteria (for example the language) in order to improve the service provided.

Profiling cookies

This site does not implement profiling cookies. Some anonymous data can be used by google analytics, to obtain complete information for this type of cookies you can directly refer to google analytics.

Why this site uses cookies

Our site uses only technical cookies. The use of cookies provides the user with a better browsing experience. Through cookies, the user, at each visit to the site, does not have to enter the same information already provided during the first visit. The cookies are also used in order to optimize the performance of the website.

Google analytics

This website uses google analytics, a web analytics service provided by google. Google analytics uses cookies, which are text files that are stored on the user's computer to allow the website to analyze how users are use the site. The information generated by the cookie on the use of the website (including the IP address) is transmitted and deposited on google servers.

Google will use this information for the purpose of evaluating the use of the website, compiling reports on website activity and provide other services relating to website activity and internet usage. Google can also transfer this information to third parties where this is required by law or where such third parties process the aforementioned information on behalf of Google.

Google will not associate the user's IP address with any other data held by google. The user can deny consent the use of cookies by selecting the dedicated setting on the browser.

By using this website, the user consents to the processing of data by google for the methods and purposes indicated above.

OPTIONALITY OF PROVIDING DATA

Apart from what is specified for navigation data, the user is free to provide personal data contained in the application forms of the company Casoni Srl or otherwise indicated in contacts with the Office to solicit the sending of informative material or other communications.

METHOD OF TREATMENT

Personal data are processed with automated tools for the time strictly necessary to achieve the purposes for which they were collected.

Specific security measures are observed to prevent the loss of data, illicit or incorrect use and non-access authorized.

RIGHTS OF THE INTERESTED PARTIES

The subjects to whom the personal data refer have the right at any time to obtain confirmation of the existence or less of the same data and to know its content and origin, verify its accuracy or request its integration or updating, or rectification (Article 7 of Legislative Decree no. 196/2003).

Pursuant to the same article, one has the right to request cancellation, transformation into anonymous form or blocking of data processed in violation of the law, as well as to oppose in any case, for legitimate reasons, to their processing.
